RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Michigan Pet Fund Alliance (MPFA) is committed to increasing the number of trapneuter-return programs to control cat populations; and

WHEREAS, MPFA is offering a grant of \$5,000 to launch such a program; and

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Animal Control seeks to apply for the grant and if awarded, will follow grant requirements to include but not limited to completing the trap-neuter-return of a minimum of 20 cats before November 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires no match; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for applying is February 14, 2020.
