**TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY:** Your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

**R E S O L U T I O N**

**WHEREAS**, Mayflower Road in Bertrand Township was recently ground up, graveled and double sealed, however, due to neighboring construction and road restrictions, it has been enduring increased truck traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the portion of Mayflower Road in St. Joe County, Indiana from Brick Road to the state line is a posted No Truck Route; and

**WHEREAS**, the Berrien County Engineer, under statute, and recommendation from the Traffic Safety Supervisor, can regulate truck traffic on roads under their jurisdiction; and

**WHEREAS**, it is recommended that Mayflower Road in Bertrand Township be posted to restrict heavy truck traffic and thus minimize the deterioration of the roadway caused by the continued use of heavy trucks.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the traffic control order which authorizes the placement of appropriate signage “NO THRU TRUCKS” be erected to indicate the restriction of truck traffic on Mayflower Road, from Bertrand Road to the Indiana state line in the Township of Bertrand and instructs that the appropriate agencies are notified
